Left: As part of our efforts to economically empower GSF beneficiaries in the communities where we operate, forty (40) women were trained in Kamuli District from 1st – 2nd August 2025.

The women were equipped with knowledge and skills on Village Savings & Loans Associations (VSLA) methodology. Two (2) VSLA groups were formed namely Agali-Awalala and Okukulakulana VSLA group.

GSF facilitated the 2 groups with branded reflectors, metallic savings boxes, member passbooks, pens, stamp, ledger book and start-up capital. Each group elected leaders who will be in charge, with support from the GSF team.



Right: On 14th August 2025, Ms. Jordana Ndawula offered a free counselling session and donated stuff (clothes, shoes, bags) to the beneficiaries at Kigo Prisons P/S. Among the issues that she addressed was poor performance and low self-esteem among some learners. She encouraged them to work hard, to always consult when they do not understand in class and to be self-driven. For the low self-esteem, she encouraged them to have a purpose and goal, surround themselves with peers of morals and values as this greatly contributes to one's confidence.
